- Creating an environment for multicultural dialogue and exchange of good artistic practices and participation in various artistic forms of contemporary culture and communications;
- Creation of an active art center with its own collection, creation and development of an Outdoor Sculpture Park;
- Generating and developing of new forms for cultural communication, organizing and conducting through various cultural events in cooperation with other institutions (private and state).

MAIN ACTIVITY:

- Development, implementation and promotion of projects in the field of visual arts and organizing original artistic events under the trademark of DUPPINI Art Group
- Running an international symposium for art in nature and an Open Door Day open air event with micro festival program for the broad audience, event with free entry;
- Organizing presentative exhibitions, art events and installations in urban spaces;
- Organizing workshops, seminars, meetings and other cultural forums in the art field;
- Developing of an Art Center with diverse program. Maintaining working and social spaces, according to the events;
- Participation and collaboration in projects in the country and abroad with other associations in the fields of science, art and culture;
- Partnership for development and implementation of art projects in accordance with the goals of the association;
- Sustaining and maintaining of an art collection: archives from Duppini Art Center, Sculpture Park Gabrovtsi and DUPPINI Art Fund;
- Launching public presentations and distribution of catalogs, brochures and other printed or electronic publications, related to the activities of the group;
- Providing opportunity for debut performance for art students, integrating them into the professional art community;
- Providing opportunity for after-graduated student internships;
- Organizing various creative workshops for children.



SUMMARY

Since 2000, the association has organized 10 consecutive international annual symposia in Dolni Duppini (later renamed to Dolni Enevets) – a village in Tryavna region of the Balkan mountain, Bulgaria. The symposiums gathered participants from Bulgaria, Macedonia, Serbia, Romania, Turkey, Netherlands, Switzerland, France, Italy and Sweden. The participants are established professional artists, working in numerous contemporary art fields such as performances, installations, media arts, plastic arts, music, theatre, photography. The objective of such performances is to revive that place and establish conditions for active cultural dialogue between artists, to create new art products, based on exchange and communication.

Since 2012, the group annually organizes Gabrovtsi ART-NATURE Symposium in the village of Gabrovtsi, Veliko Tarnovo area, Bulgaria. The symposium is a sustainable Bulgarian event without analogue in the country, with participants from Japan, Korea, Germany, Italy, France, Mexico, Taiwan, South Africa, England, Romania, Macedonia, Serbia, China, Norway, Belgium, Turkey, USA, Hungary, Israel and Bulgaria with assistants from University of Veliko Tarnovo, Bulgaria. The event also includes seminars, artist's presentations, children's creative workshops, exhibitions, open door days.

Since 2013, Duppini Art Group is a partnering organisation of the Global Nomadic Art Project of YATOO Art Group - South Korea. (<u>The World Nature Art Catalogue</u>, pp. 18–21). **In 2017**, Duppini Art Group was co-organizer of Global Nomadic Art Project, Eastern Europe.

Since 2014, Duppini Art Group has been working on the transformation of a former Labor and Educational School in the village of Gabrovtsi, Veliko Tarnovo area, turning it into an active center with a residence for contemporary arts and culture. Now the location is known as Duppini Art Center & Residency.
